4. Planning and start the "process" again with changes. Just like when you are on the green, wanting to play your next end. Even after a bad loss you always get back on the green .....



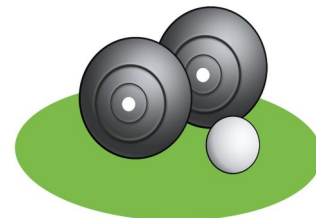

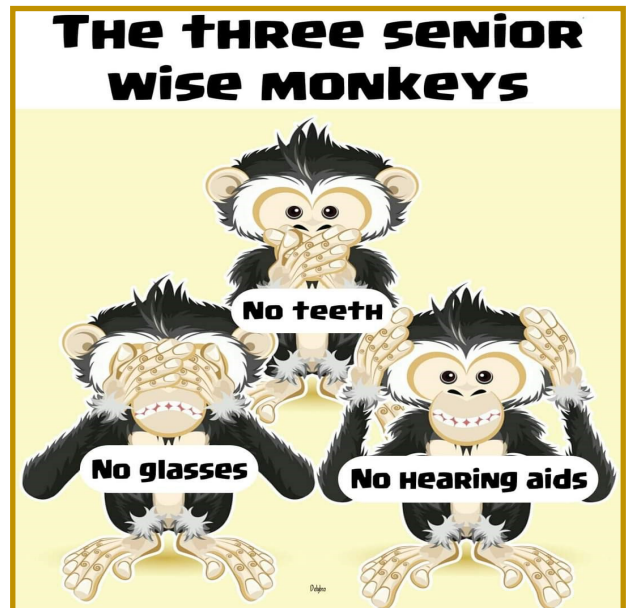


**THE BOWLER'S OWN LANGUAGE - HOW TO TRANSLATE**

| " I 'D BOWL WITH HIM ANY DAY"   | He always buys the first round                    |

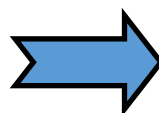

**The Protection of Personal Information Act 4 of 2013 (POPIA)** came into effect on the first of July 2021. Jeffreys Bay Bowling Club ("the Club") gives all its members the assurance that it will comply with POPIA in all respects and that as your privacy is as important to the club as it is to you, the Club aims to ensure that stringent measures are implemented so as to safeguard your personal information

In accordance with POPIA, the Club will appoint an Information Officer and register the information officer at the Information Regulator.

The Club undertakes to do everything in its power to ensure that all personal information in its possession does not fall victim to unlawful access and such personal information is protected from damage and unauthorized destruction.

As you are aware, the personal information which you have furnished the Club is intended for use within the sport of Bowls and the Club undertakes to use such information only for the purpose for which it was gathered.

Be assured that the Club will NOT use personal information for marketing purposes or furnish your information to any third party. In order to ensure full compliance with POPIA and to maintain our POPIA records as required by law, we will be printing a separate document for each of our members and request that you give your express consent to use your personal information by signing this document. This document will be attached to your application form and kept safe by the Club Secretary. New application forms already have the POPIA consent included for signature by prospective new members.

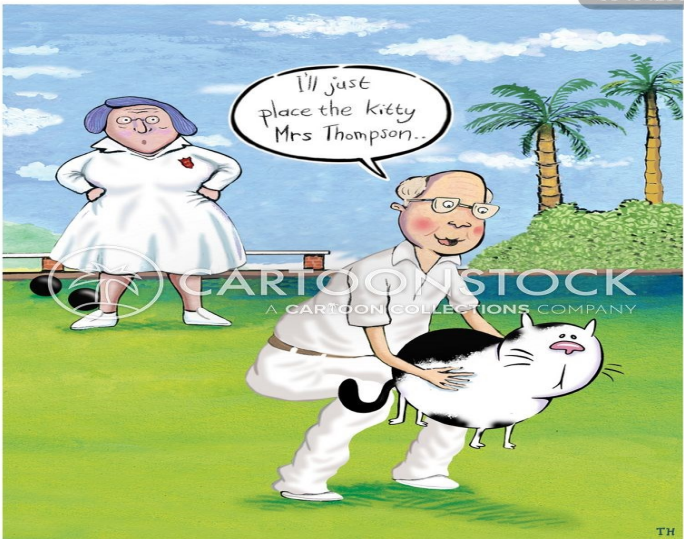
