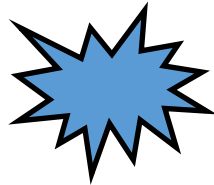

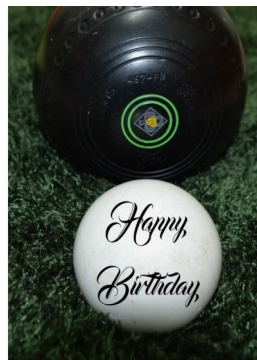

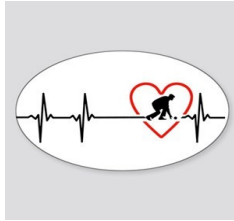

About eight months ago, Eric Maskell was diagnosed with AML, Acute Myeloid Leukemia.

This is a type of cancer of the blood and bone marrow with ex immature white blood cells .

AML progresses rapidly, with myeloid cells interfering with the production of normal white blood cell, red blood cells and platelets.

It was then decided to go to a Clinical Heamatologist doctor, and that Cape Town would be where he would find help. The diagnoses was confirmed and the game started. It was also said that the only hope on cure would be to have a bone marrow transplant.

After been treated with drastic chemo therapy, the search was on to find a bone marrow donor. The first blood was drawn from Eric's brother and sisters, as this often is a good place to start the searching for a matching donor. This blood that gets drawn goes through a two week process. The result being that both Eric's brother and sister were 100% match to him.

Eric was sent home to become stronger and recover as much as possible, and to remain infection free. After losing 50kg in this first round of treatment, he had to work very hard, step by step, to achieve this level which the drs felt he would cope with another round of drastic chemo and followed by a bone marrow cell transplant.

It was decided that Zaretha would be the donor, as she was the youngest sibling to Eric.

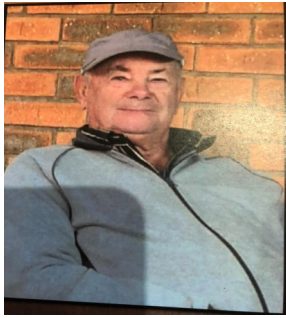
Zaretha was then put through a number of blood tests, ECG, full medical and Xrays of chest and lungs, to make 100% sure her life is not at any form of risk as a donor. Treatment for Zaretha commenced and was synchronised with Eric's chemo. Zaretha was treated for 5 days with injections twice a day. The injections would stimulate her bone marrow to produce more stem cells. These cells then pour out into her blood and on the day she was hospitalised and a machine then removes these cells from her blood and collects them in a transfusion bag.

The following day, the bone marrow cells were given to Eric via a drip. Eric then stays in hospital until the blood tests start to show progress. He was kept in hospital for three weeks and is slowly improving.

Weekly he sees his doctor. The doctor then draws blood and puts him on a drip. This drip is to support his immunity. The blood test show whether the new bone marrow is producing white and red blood cells and platelets. These patients are very prone to infection and the blood tests will also show any possible infections.

Eric will be in Cape Town for 100 days, post donation. Then only do you know if all is on tract.

Eric is very positive, has been infection free and slowly starting to eat. He sure has a story to tell.

As **gesinslid** was hy altyd daar vir sy gesinslede. 'n Kind se grondslag en gemoedsrus vind hy in die streng dissipline wat hy in sy ouerhuis ontvang het. Dit was met Abrie ook die geval. Abrie het altyd die seding gehad: **Pa is Pa**. As hy dus sy se gese het moet almal in die gesin weet dat daar nou klaar oor die onderwerp gepraat is en die saak afgehandel is.

Abrie het later begin **rolbal speel** en was baie lief vir die spel. Tot 2 maande voor sy dood het hy nog aktief gespeel en op die "**Tabskomitee**" gedien waar hy, as dit die week sy beurt was, elke Woensdag, Vrydag en Saterdag al die spelers wat kom speel se tabs in ontvangs geneem het. Gewoonlik het Abrie net **een drankie** na rolbal gedrink en dan huistoe gegaan. Baie kere het ek – Johann Neethling - hom gekry op pad uit en dan se ek : Abrie kom drink nog iets saam met my? Dan het hy altyd gese: Nee dankie Neethling, ek is nie soos jy nie, ek het 'n vrou by die huis.

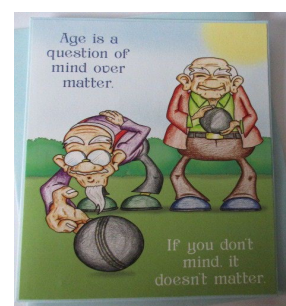
